Statement regarding Directive 94/62/EC of 20 December 1994 on packaging and packaging waste

For the ingredients of MJ Addistat 28 we have confirmation of our suppliers that all ingredients are in compliance with directive 94/62/EC on packaging and packaging waste.

Heavy metals do not form part of the standard specification for the above mentioned product and as such is not routinely analysed for. We can advise that lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium are not intentionally added to our product MJ Addistat 28 and are not formed during its production. There also is no indication for their presence in any of the raw-materials used and would only be expected to be present at trace levels.
